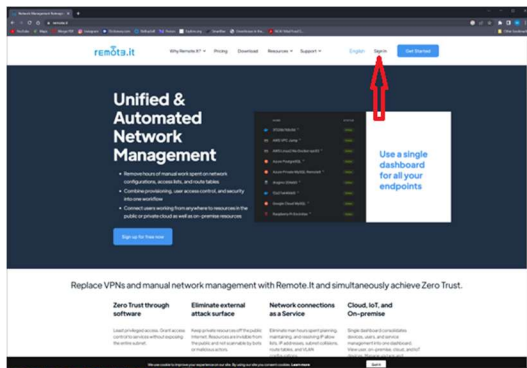


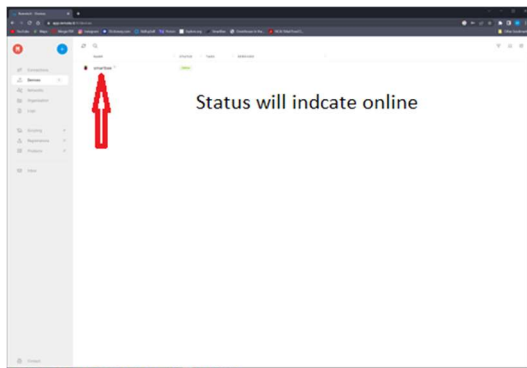


Configuring *remote.it* services

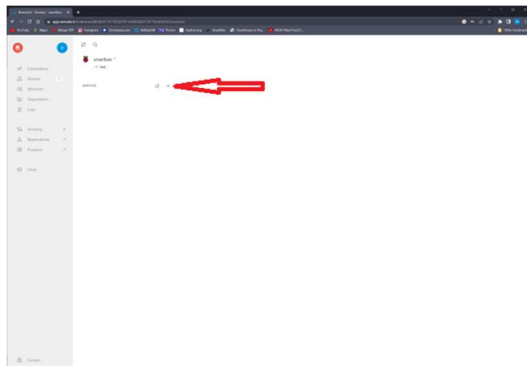
After you have created an account, you will need to use either the *remote.it* web interface or the *remote.it* desktop application to configure the required services. You will need to configure 2 services, one to get to the Hive log in page and a second to log into the Hive application. These services are difficult to create on the iOS or Android app



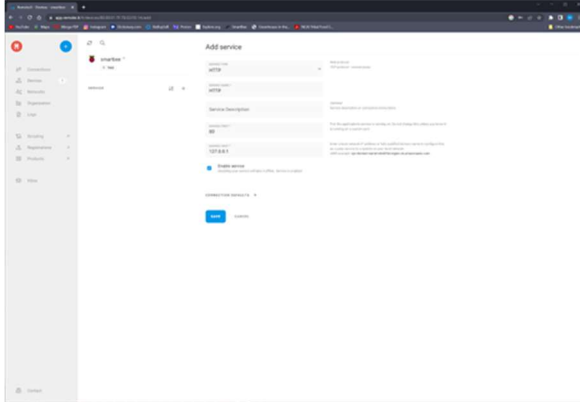
- 1.) If you completed the steps to load *remote.it* on your Hive, you should see smartbee listed under Devices This will bring you to the connection page for the services you created earlier.



- 2.) If you completed the steps to load *remote.it* on your Hive, you should see smartbee listed under Devices. Its status should be “online”. Click on the smartbee device.

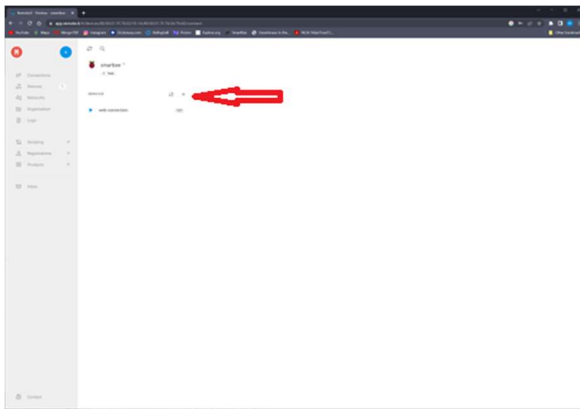


- 3.) Click on the plus sign “+” to configure the first service.

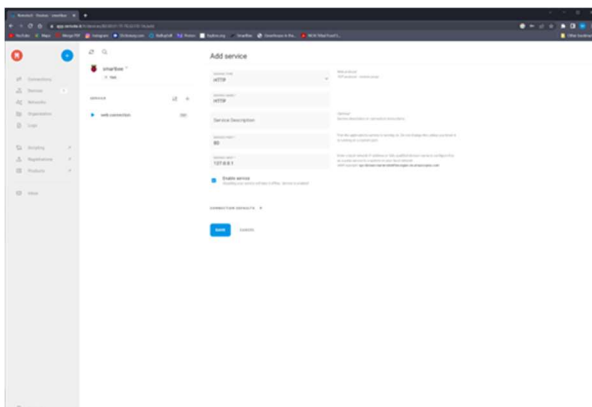


4.) This brings you to the “Add Service” page.

- a. Under “SERVICE TYPE” select: **TCP**
- b. Under “SERVICE NAME” Enter: **web connection**
- c. Under “SERVICE PORT” Enter: **80**
- d. Click save

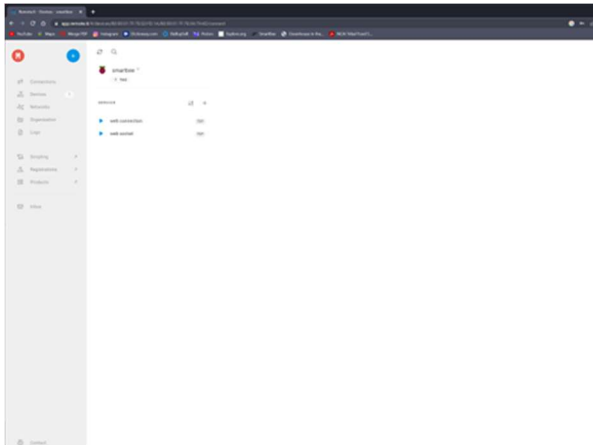


5.) Click the plus sign “+” to configure the second service.



6.) This brings you to the “Add Service” page.

- a. Under “SERVICE TYPE” select: **TCP**
- b. Under “SERVICE NAME” enter: **web socket**
- c. Under “SERVICE PORT” Enter: **7090**
- d. Click save



7.) The 2 services have been configured. You can log out.

8.) See either desktop application or iOS & Android login instructions to log into your Hive.
